Where and When and Who:

We're heading back to Denton, TX (Texas Women's University) from August 1-5: www.studentlife.com/events/home-missions.php For this week we'll focus on **students in grades 6 - 8 during the 2009-2010 academic year.**

What is Student Life Mission Camp?

There will be times of inspiring worship, instructional and challenging messages, awesome small group interaction, and a service project in the community! Camp combined with Missions ... pure greatness!!

The Plan:

We'll leave from Keller on **Sunday, August 1st.** After getting lunch along the way, we'll arrive in Denton ready for camp. Camp concludes on **Thursday, August 5th.** During the days at camp, we'll begin with devotionals and breakfast. After a brief all-camp session, we'll head into the community for a service project that Student Life will coordinate for us to serve at. After serving, a lunch break, and a couple more hours of serving, we'll head back to camp for some free time. Following dinner, we'll have our Bible study for the week ('Re'). For the evening, we'll join the rest of the students for the all-camp activities. If you've never been to Student Life Camp, you will love it! Just ask anyone who's gone before. With the added Missions Project, **this week will be a growing and Christ-glorifying week!**

The Cost:

\$275 total ... \$50 non-refundable deposit due by March 30th

If two or more students from the same family attend a mission camp, each student will receive a **\$25 family discount.**

Final balance (after discounts and fundraisers are applied) due **June 23rd.**

Covered in the cost: transportation, the fees for camp and mission project supplies, all meals at camp.

Not covered: two fast food-type meals on the way to and from Denton, snacks, souvenirs, CDs, etc., at camp.

Mind-Set and Preparation:

To get us thinking about Missions and service, read a brief biography of a missions-minded person and write a short report on what you learned. Some biographies will be suggested (or choose one that interests you) and reflect on the life of this person with a short report (suggestions and questions available in April). Complete this reading and report by **June 13th** to earn **\$25** toward your Mission Camp.

More financial info:

Fund-raisers: The total amount that the student earned through fundraisers (Submarine Sandwich Sales from the Super Bowl, Rent-A-Teen, Bake Sale) will be deducted from the final amount due.

Raising Support: Another way to help with cost is to do what missionaries do: talk to others about the mission and see how God directs them to help financially and prayerfully. (See the sample letter or ask Kyle for more info.)
